CAMP DIRECTORS



Kim Cherniss is starting her 20th year as head coach of the Coyotes. She has guided the Coyotes to thirteen straight 20 win seasons. The team's record in that span is 355-64. The team reached the NCAA Pacific Regional finals over the past 8 years, and won the title in 2003, 2004, and 2009. The Coyotes have also won their California Collegiate Athletic Association titles in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2006, 2007 and 2009. Her overall record since coming to CSUSB is 415-178.



Kim Cherniss

Cherniss is a three-time CCAA "Coach of the Year (1997, 2001 and 2002) and was the 2001 and 2003 West Region "Coach of the Year."

Before coming to CSUSB, Cherniss competed for eight years at the collegiate, international and professional levels of volleyball. She was a member of the San Bernardino Jazz pro volleyball team. She was a two-time All-American at UC Riverside and a member of the Highlanders' 1982 NCAA championship team. She was inducted into the UCR Sports Hall of Fame in 1991.

Cherniss began her coaching career as head coach of a professional team in France. She began coaching club volleyball teams upon her return to the United States and coached inland area club volleyball teams for five years.

Danny Scott, the 2009 NCAA Division II Assistant Coach of the Year, has been an assistant coach for the Coyotes since 1997. He took 2000 off to work on his master's degree in kinesiology at Cal State Fullerton. He is also one of the top club coaches in the Inland Empire. He coaches the Rancho Valley Volleyball Club team.

He played two years of college volleyball at San Diego Mesa Community College and one year at CSUSB. Scott earned his B.S. in kinesiology at CSUSB in 1998.
